**MUSICAL THOUGHTS**

Our limited human ability to foresee an outcome is only based on what we know from previous experiences. We must rely on our faith to believe that God and only God, is in charge and is capable of making the outcomes different than what we see through our human understanding. The healing of Jairus's daughter in today's Gospel, is just one example. We really do have a challenge some days to recognize the small miracles in our lives that happen every day. God cares for us as much as Jesus cared for Jairus's daughter and the woman. "O let all who seek, let them come to the water. And let all who are weary, let them come to the Lord", are lyrics we will sing as the gifts are presented to the altar. When we proceed to the altar to receive the Eucharist, please think about the words, "I will come to you in the silence, I will lift you from all your fear. You will hear my voice, I claim you as my choice, be still and know I am here." These lyrics from "You Are Mine" are what Our Lord is saying to us. What happens to us is in His plan, and not sometimes what we thought should be our plan. In my living room is a wall hanging that fits these thoughts.
