### Musical Thoughts

This weekend we are celebrating the "Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity". "Holy, Holy, Holy", our opening hymn today, and our closing hymn, "Holy God, We Praise Thy Name", both refer to the Triune God. Without even thinking about it, possibly many times a day, we refer to the Trinity, for example, "In the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit" we say as we make the sign of the Cross; "Glory be the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit" we pray as a part of the rosary. Elaine Rendler discusses that in the popular book, "The Shack", the protagonist asks God to help him understand the idea of the Trinity. God says, "If I were simply One God and only One Person, then you would find yourself in this Creation without something wonderful." Sing our closing hymn as a prayer, "Holy Father, Holy Son, Holy Spirit, Three we name thee; While in essence only One".
