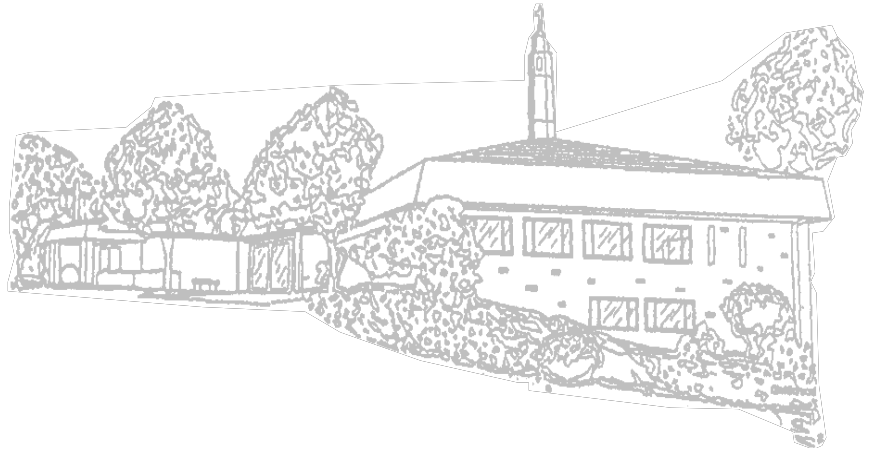

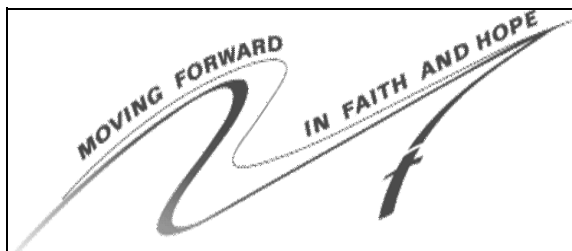
The Knights of Columbus encourage your attendance and will provide financial support if needed to any parish member, either woman or man, who wish to attend the CEW weekend.
